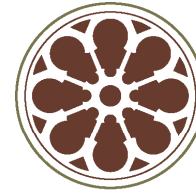

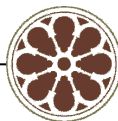

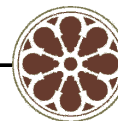
The Worship Team and Cabinet have made a very important decision about our Easter worship services. Because of the steadily increasing attendance in Easter's past, we have decided to have two worship (very similar) services this Easter. The first service will be in the Historic Sanctuary at 8:30 AM, and the second will be in the CMC at 10:30 AM. There will be no Sunday School on that Sunday. The choir will sing at both services, and the order of worship will be the same.
