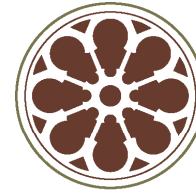

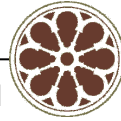

## Life Together by Mickey Anders



The Roxburgh process is moving forward with some interesting results. As you may be aware, we are participating in this process through the Region of Kentucky where fourteen other Disciples churches are meeting quarterly with Alan Roxburgh.

In the last quarter, Holly and I asked twenty people each to fill out an online survey regarding our skills and strengths for ministry. At our recent meeting in Louisville, we received reports on those surveys, and will spend the next few months studying the results, getting more feedback and developing an enrichment plan to make us better ministers.

Our Guiding Team (Timothea Branham, Steve Feese, Jack McAllister, Janet Warren, and Sharon White) has conducted interviews with about thirty of our members, and they are in the process of compiling a single narrative from those interviews, which they will share with the congregation. After that, we will be asking ALL our members to fill out an online survey regarding our church. At our next meeting with Alan Roxburgh in May, we will receive results from those surveys.

Our theme for the year has been selected in coordination with the Roxburgh process. Based on a study of Luke 10:1-12, he is pushing all our churches to move out into our communities. So we have chosen the theme, "Getting Out is In."

The theme means that it is "in" to get out into our communities in ministry. Perhaps you noticed our new "Getting Out is In" logo, which was on the screen on Sunday and is on the front page of this Current.

Every other week, we are using this benediction as a reminder of our theme: Now it is time to get out of church. We get out of church to get into the world.

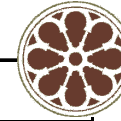

### Call for Acolytes



The role of the acolyte in the worship service is a very important one. Lighting the candles at the beginning of worship

symbolizes God's presence in our midst. As the acolyte carries the flame out at the end of worship, God's light goes out with us into the world.

All children of South Elkhorn are eligible to be acolytes. Children ages 6 years old and up are usually ready to handle this level of responsibility. We encourage all children to consider serving their church in this important way.

Scheduled acolytes need to arrive at least 5 minutes before the start of the service. Schedules covering four-month periods are mailed three times a year. Generally, acolytes serve once every six weeks. A training session for new and continuing acolytes will be held immediately following worship on Sunday, March 14th. Acolytes for the year will be installed during worship on March 21.
