### What to Bring

- \* Pillow
- \* Sleeping Bag/Sheets
- \* Casual Clothing-Shorts, Jeans, Shirts, Shoes, etc.
- \* Swimsuits for Water Games.
- \* Towels, Soap, Shampoo, Deodorant, Tooth Brush, Toothpaste, etc.
- \* Bible, Pencils, etc.
- \* Musical Instrument
- \* Flashlight with Batteries
- \* Canteen and Offering Money.
- \* Rain Coat
- \* Camera
- \* IPOD with headphones for use in cabin only

**Be sure to mark your belongings!!!!**

### What not to bring...

- \* Laptops, Portable DVD Players, Video Game Systems. Etc.
- \* Cell Phones, they are Cell phones first, not Cameras or IPod's.
- \* Weapons of any kind.
- \* Alcohol, Drugs, Tobacco products or Electronic Vapor cigarettes
- \* Fireworks
- \* **NO** candy or food in cabins - they attract wildlife
- \* Camper **WILL** be sent home before the end of the event if weapons, fireworks, alcohol, or tobacco products are found.
- \* **ALL** electronic devices not allowed at camp will be confiscated and returned at the end of the week.

## 2018 Camp Information for Parents, Guardians, Ministers, Leaders & Volunteers

### Camp Rules & Expectations

- \* The use of any tobacco products or electronic vapor cigarettes is prohibited.
- \* No "graffiti" of any kind is permitted. Campers/Parents will pay for any graffiti or damage to cabins, shelters, etc...
- \* Campers are expected to stay the full time and should not leave the camp at anytime without permission of the Camp Director.
- \* Any camper driving to camp will not be allowed to leave camp early without written permission of parent or guardian.
- \* **VISTORS** are **NOT** permitted during camp.
- \* **Emergencies:** In case of a family emergency please contact the campsite by telephone and ask to speak to a Director. In the event that a camper needs emergency medical treatment a camp director will contact parents via the emergency contact number (606-787-6564)
- \* **Medications:** Please send updated list of all medications, include dosage and frequency. Send all Medications - prescription and over the counter in original containers. Emergency medications are to be brought to camp; these include Epipens, Insulin, etc.... If a camper arrives without these, they will be sent home.
- \* Do not show up at a camp unannounced or without the approval of a camp director.
- \* **Medical Insurance:** Be sure to list all medical insurance information. If a camper must go to the hospital during camp we will list the family insurance as primary insurance.
- \* **Refunds:** If cancellation is necessary, notify the Regional Office. All cancellations are subject to a \$15 Administrative fee withheld from the refund. If you cancel at least 14 days prior to the event, the registration fee, minus \$15, will be returned. If you cancel 13-10 days prior, 50% will be refunded. No camp fees will be refunded for cancellations less than 10 days prior to the beginning of a camp. **NO camp fees will be refunded for no-shows.**
- \* All Phone Messages will be relayed through the Adult Camp Staff to campers. Campers will not be called to the phone. The phone is not available for campers.
- \* **Liability:** The Christian Church in Kentucky is not responsible for personal items that are lost, stolen, or broken at camp.
- \* **Equal Opportunity:** WKDH is open to all regardless of race, creed, color, gender or national origin.
