2020 Camp Information for Parents, Guardians, Ministers, Leaders & Volunteers

Camp Rules & Expectations

- * The use of any tobacco products or electronic vapor cigarettes is prohibited.
- * No "graffiti" of any kind is permitted. Campers/Parents will pay for any graffiti or damage to cabins, shelters, etc...
- * Campers are expected to stay the full time and should not leave the camp at anytime without permission of the Camp Director.
- * The Pool is off limits EXCEPT during DESIGNATED TIMES.
- * Any camper driving to camp will not be allowed to leave camp early without written permission of parent or guardian.
- * VISTIORS are NOT permitted during camp.
- * Emergencies: In case of a family emergency please contact the campsite by telephone and ask to speak to a Director. In the event that a camper needs emergency medical treatment, a camp director will contact parents via the emergency contact number (606-787-6564)
- * Medications: Please send updated list of all medications, include dosage and frequency.

 Send all Medications prescriptions and over the counter in their original containers.

 Campers who need emergency medications must bring them to camp; these include Epi-Pens, Insulin, etc.... If a camper arrives without these, they will be sent home.
- * Do not show up at a camp unannounced or without the approval of a camp director.
- * Medical Insurance: Be sure to list all medical insurance information. If a camper must go to the hospital during camp, we will list the family insurance as primary insurance.
- * Refunds: If cancellation is necessary, notify the Regional Office. All cancellations are subject to a \$15 Administrative fee withheld from the refund. If you cancel at least 14 days prior to the event, the registration fee, minus \$15, will be returned. If you cancel 13-10 days prior, 50% will be refunded. No camp fees will be refunded for cancellations less than 10 days prior to the beginning of a camp. NO camp fees will be refunded for no-shows.
- * All phone messages will be relayed through the Adult Camp Staff to campers. Campers will not be called to the phone. The phone is not available for campers.
- * Liability: The Christian Church in Kentucky is not responsible for personal items that are lost, stolen, or broken at camp.
- * Equal Opportunity: WKDH is open to all regardless of race, creed, color, gender or national origin.
